ITALIAN MOVIE NIGHT AT CSU-PUEBLO

Please join us for a screening of Emanuele Crialese's *Terraferma* (Dry Land) on Tuesday, April 12th at 5:30 pm in the Language Center, Psychology 147. (English subtitles)

This 2011 film takes place on the Italian island of Linosa, one of the Pelagie Islands of Sicily (population 430). The movie presents the current immigration crisis in Italy and how the Italian peninsula is a Mecca for displaced peoples seeking a better life for themselves. The island's fishermen are punished for saving illegal immigrants from the sea and, once on shore, letting them go. A young local islander named Filippo does not allow them on his boat. Several die and Filippo changes his mind about the matter: he helps a family consisting of a mother, a little boy and a newborn baby, to reach the Italian mainland. Running time - 88 minutes

TOUCHED BY THE HANDS OF GOD: MICHELANGELO'S MODELS


