

The Dante Alighieri Society of Pueblo is pleased to award \$1500 scholarships to area high school seniors who have completed two or more years of Italian. Eligible students must have a 3.5 GPA in Italian and a 3.0 GPA overall.

Scholarship application instructions:

- 1. Complete the attached application.
- 2. Provide two letters of recommendation.
- 3. Submit an official high school transcript (If not available, submit an unofficial transcript)

If selected, you will be honored at the scholarship awards luncheon at the **Pueblo Country Club on Sunday, May 1, 2022, at 12:00 PM.** Winners should be prepared to say a few words in Italian thanking the organization for the scholarship.

Scholarship winners will receive a check for \$500 at the scholarship awards luncheon in May. To receive the remaining \$1000 scholarship award students must:

1. Successfully complete (grade of C or better) one year (2 semesters or 3 trimesters) of Italian at an accredited university. The Italian courses must be completed following high school graduation.

## Concurrent enrollment courses do not fulfill this requirement.

- 2. Submit an unofficial transcript and contact information to the scholarship committee
- 3. Complete the Italian courses within four academic years after your high school graduation.
